

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT THE KATE'S MARQUEE CLUB

The Marquee Club is a new hospitality space that is used by sponsors and for other special events. From time to time, the Kate invites Members at the Best Supporting Actor level and above to join us in the Club for a beverage before shows.

How many people can comfortably fit in the Marquee Club? The room can accommodate up to 25 guests.

How will I know when the Marquee Club is open and available to me? You will receive an email invitation from Robin.Andreoli@thekate.org two or three days prior to the event for which you have tickets. The Kate hopes to begin text message notification as an option in the coming months.

Can I just stop in if I see other people in the Marquee Club? If you have not received an email invitation prior to the show, it's likely that the Club is being used for a private event.

May I bring guests/friends who are not Members to the Marquee Club? Thank you for introducing friends to the Kate! We will try to accommodate these requests based on number of guests on the night in question and ask that you email Robin.Andreoli@thekate.org at least one day in advance with your request.

Is the Marquee Club handicap accessible? Yes, the Club is located on the first floor of the Kate, adjacent to the Katharine Hepburn Museum.

Can I order a mixed drink in the Marquee Club? No, at this time we only offer beer, wine and soft drinks. You may purchase a mixed drink at the Kate bar and bring it into the Club.

Can I reserve the Marquee Club for a private event? Members at the Best Leading Actor level and above may request to use the Marquee Club for a private event. Requests will be granted based upon availability and additional costs for beverages and/or food will apply.

Can children or youth attend the Marquee Club? When accompanied by a parent or guardian, children and youth under age 21 may attend events in the Club.
